

Airbag containment Devices.....

I do not recommend to any fire department to use any brand of airbag containment device.

Devices are not UL listed.

Devices have no guarantee.

Devices may not perform as designed due to collapsible steering wheel feature on U.s. manufactured automobiles.

Transportation Emergency Rescue Committee (www.terc.org) did hands-on research years ago, had lots of failures, and won't recommend using them.

U.S. DOT states not to use them in their airbag video.

Auto manufacturers advise to not cover any undeployed airbag.

Even when in place, they only cover one airbag. Frontal can now include driver and passenger frontal airbags plus driver and passenger knee bags.

Lawyers will prove that it wasn't the automakers airbag that deployed during the rescue and injured the plaintiff. It was in fact the fire department's unapproved airbag containment device that struck, injured, or killed the patient.
